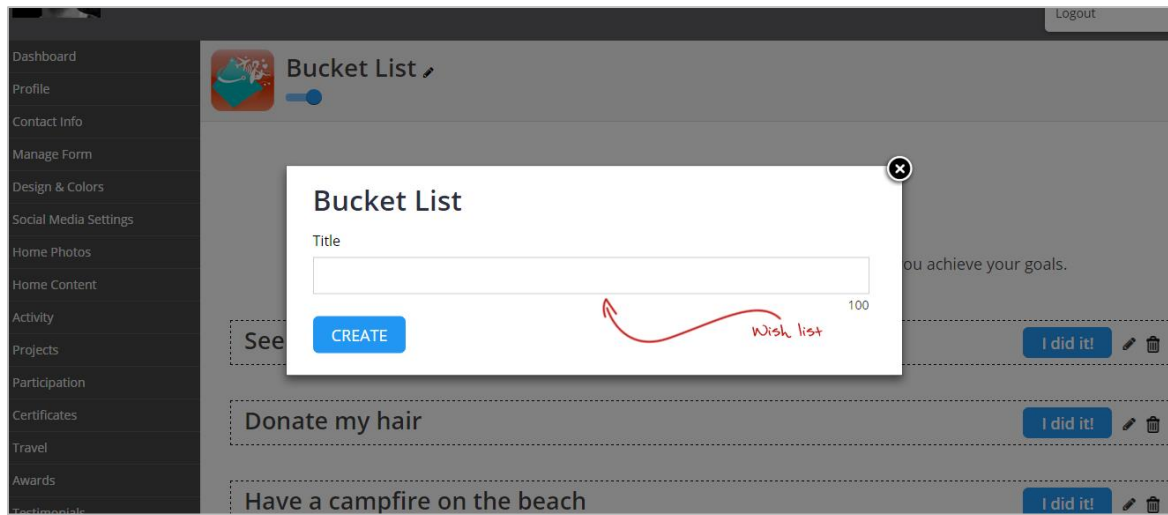
Bucket List

Go to the link "Bucket List"

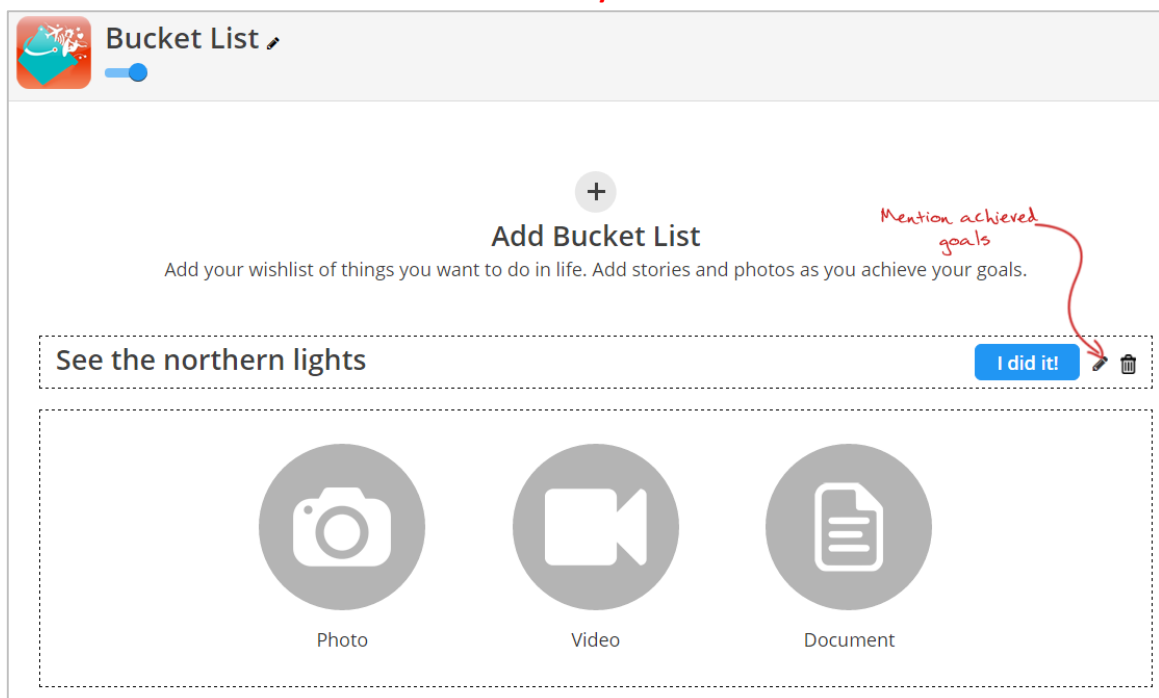
- **Bucket List:** Pen down the things that you have always wanted to do like bungee jumping, swim with a sea turtle, donate hair and so on.
